Derry Past & Present

Uncover Derry-Londonderry's past and present on a tour around the city's historic buildings.

- 1. The Apprentice Boys Memorial Hall. Situated within the historic 17th century walls this listed neo-gothic building houses a museum dedicated to the history and heritage of the Siege of Londonderry 1688-1689. Discover the story of this extraordinary siege and the part played by the Apprentice Boys from artefacts and engrossing video presentations. BT48 6PJ
- 2. Next visit the neo-gothic Guildhall, home to one of Irelands largest collections of stained glass windows. The ornate ceilings, oak panelling and magnificent concert organ make the Guildhall one of the most striking buildings in the city. BT48 6BB
- 3. Discover the peoples story of the struggle for civil rights, the Battle of the Bogside and Bloody Sunday at the newly opened Museum of Free Derry. BT48 9DR
