Walled Wonder

Discover the local history and culture of Irelands only completely walled city.

1. 17th century city walls and St Columb's Cathedral, built between 1614 and 1619, the historic walls are almost perfectly preserved, making Derry-Londonderry one of the finest examples of a walled city in Europe. BT48 4RQ
2. Next visit the award-winning Tower Museum. This recently refurbished museum houses two state of the art exhibitions; the 'Story of Derry' and the 'Armada Shipwreck', which showcases artefacts unearthed from the La Trinidad Valancera, found wrecked off the Donegal Coast. Complete your visit with panoramic views of the city from the museum's open air rooftop. BT48 6LU
3. Later in the afternoon, why not indulge in some retail therapy? The Richmond Centre and Foyleside have a huge range of high street stores while the Craft Village specialises in local craft and unique gifts such as crystal glassware. Or why not visit Austin's, the worlds oldest department store.
